- international network of academic cooperation and trust inspired by Humboldt's example









- online applications at any time to the Foundation directly
- assessment by independent peer reviewers

- duration of procedure: approximately 4 to 7 months

# Award Programmes





#### Humboldt Research Award (by nomination)

- for internationally eminent academics from abroad
- up to €60,000, research stay in Germany

#### Friedrich Wilhelm Bessel Research Award (by nomination)

- for experienced, internationally-respected academics from abroad up to 18 years after completion of doctorate
- up to €45,000, research stay in Germany





- prepare your application well in advance and calculate with some extra time
- take your time to find an appropriate academic host
- choose the right time to submit your application (PhD (almost) completed? Already abroad?)
- postdoctoral researchers should ensure that the key findings of their doctoral thesis are already published
- the research outline should not be a direct continuation of the doctoral thesis or of the academic work carried out to date
